
## GUIDE TO INCOTERMS® 2020





FCA: Delivery is made either when goods are (1) loaded on the means of transport provided by the buyer at the seller's stated location; or (2) when placed at the disposal of the buyer's carrier, cleared for export by the seller. From either point of delivery, he Buyer bears the costs and risks of moving the goods to destination. The named place/address is required when FCA is used.
